A Message from Jokey

Dear Brothers and Sisters

As we approach harvest season in the church there is much to reflect on around creation - at the moment disasters such as that which has hit Nepal and the extraordinary weather over this summer may bring us to our knees in repentance for the human errors which have destroyed the balance which God designed.

Gandhi's famous phrase 'The world has enough for everyone's need, but not enough for human greed' resonates too. God has provided us with an abundance of good things but Jesus' parables are full of examples of those like the landowner who fills his barns, not to provide for those in need but to build up his own wealth by exploiting others...

So this is a good time to balance thankfulness for what we have with collecting for those who are struggling by supporting the work of MRCT and the Foodbank.

Some reading this may themselves not be in a position to give and may need help and support - but we can all pray. There is another pressing human need we could focus on:

'Then Jesus said to his disciples, "The harvest is plentiful but the workers are few. Ask the Lord of the harvest, therefore, to send out workers into his harvest field."' (Matthew 9:37-38)

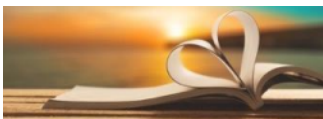
